This included designing protocols for physical and neurological evaluations and for a subsample of sixty, an intensive assessment of psychological health.

As a consultant to North Suffolk Mental Health Clinic, I did psychometric evaluations and provided therapy to children and families. I taught residents from Massachusetts General Hospital, as well as social work and nursing students. I also consulted to the pediatrics section of the neighborhood health clinic and to the Winthrop Public School system.

As program director, I have organized the department's teaching program and designed Standards of care delivery. I organized the department's teaching program, consisting of seminars, rounds and case conferences.
